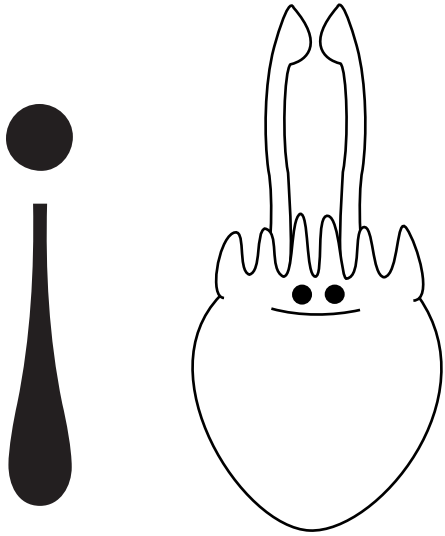

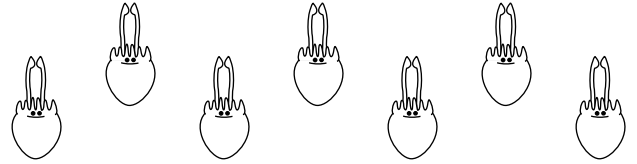

● According to real live scientists, squid now outweigh humans in terms of total bio-mass.

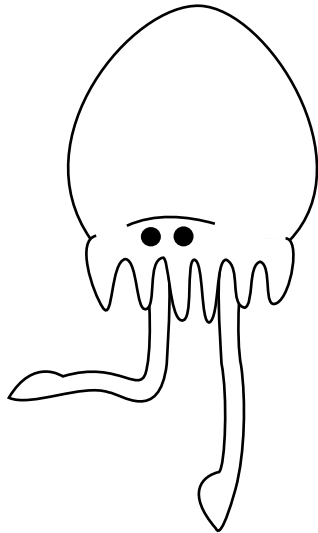
● That means they take up more space on the planet than us. Their growth rates and body size also seem to be increasing.
